Title of Report	Lucy Plackett Playing Field
Summary	To discuss additional signage for the Lucy Plackett Playing Field.
Recommendation	To erect additional signage in the playing field asking users of the field not to drop litter and not to let their dogs foul in the playing field.
Reasons for the Recommendation	To ensure that the playing field does not look untidy and is not unhygienic for those using the playing field.
Impact on Budget	Signs previously purchased were £40 each and these would also have to be erected, which would incur an additional cost.
Risks	Dog mess left on the field is a health hazard for those using the facility and littering makes the area look very untidy.
Background	<p>There have been numerous complaints about littering and dog fouling in the playing field. The Football Club has reported that before their home games, they have to pick up dog mess from the pitch to ensure it is playable and litter is often left around the MUGA.</p> <p>There are a number of litter bins/dog waste bins around the field and it could help the situation if users were reminded to make use of them. If the issue does not improve, the Parish Council could consider engaging the services of the Dog Warden at Cherwell District Council.</p>
