<b>Summary</b>	To discuss the outcomes of the meeting with the County Council Highway Officers regarding the parking issues in Croft Lane and at its junction with High Street.
<b>Recommendation</b>	To approve the outcomes of the meeting with the County Council Highway Officers regarding the parking issues in Croft Lane and at its junction with High Street.
<b>Reasons for the Recommendation</b>	To address the issues of parking in Croft Lane and at the junction with High Street.
<b>Impact on Budget</b>	Unknown at this time.
<b>Risks</b>	None.
<b>Background</b>	<p>The Parish Council has received a number of complaints from residents with regard to parking issues in this location. Therefore, a meeting was held with Dave Catling (OCC Highways), the Chairman of the Parish Council and Parish Councillor Lucy Wells to discuss ways to address these.</p> <p>There was also a discussion about the village signage, especially on The Green and Mr Catling agreed to assist with this matter too.</p> <p>The following was agreed:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Mr Catling to suggest how to improve signage on the traffic island by the Green.</li> <li>2. Mr Catling to suggest suitable signage at Oak Tree junction and at the opposite end of village, to discourage unnecessary vehicle movements through village.</li> <li>3. Removal of 'West Adderbury' signage because this encourages motorists to drive through the village, at both ends of village. It is preferable to remove all of these signs.</li> <li>4. Mr Catling to supply designs and wording for all business signs replacing with OCC approved brown information signage</li> <li>5. Mr Catling to suggest how to address parking across driveways in Croft Lane and in High Street.</li> <li>6. Parking spaces near the Coffee Shop/Hairdressers/Village Shop to be</li> </ol>

	<p>allocated and time limited during daytime only, which will enable residents/customers at the pub to park longer in the evenings.</p> <p>7. Councillor Wells has consulted with residents and the Clerk will send official letter once the Parish Council has considered the proposals.</p> <p>8. The Parish Council will inform businesses of the proposals once the Parish Council has considered them.</p>
