| <b>Summary</b>   | To update the Parish Council on the traffic calming project.   |
| <b>Recommendation</b>  | The report be noted.   |
| <b>Reasons for the Recommendation</b>  | To keep the Parish Council up to date with the traffic calming project.  |
| <b>Impact on Budget</b>  | Each traffic calming measure has been costed and will be covered by the PC budget, OCC budgets or Section 106 funds.   |
| <b>Risks</b>   | Traffic calming measures are being introduced to slow the traffic in the village which will hopefully result in fewer accidents.   |
| <b>Background</b>  | <p>Since the last meeting of the Parish Council, more volunteers have come forward to assist with the 'Adderbury Speedwatch' and also to investigate the Twyford 'rat-run'.</p> <p>To progress the Twyford 'rat-run' guidance is required from the County Council and the two volunteers are waiting to hear how they can progress this project and establish if it is feasible to close any roads in Twyford and/or introduce other measures.</p> <p>The two consultation processes for the proposed chicanes on Milton Road and Berry Hill Road and the closure of the western arm of 'oak tree' junction have both started. This has included an article in the Banbury Guardian to highlight the consultations.</p> <p>The new road markings are in the County Council's schedule and will be completed in due course.</p> |
