Title of Report	Traffic Calming
Summary	To note the progress with the traffic calming project
Recommendation	<p>Note the report.</p> <p>Support the traffic survey being conducted by the County Council.</p> <p>Support the survey for the proposal of 20 mph limit restrictions in Adderbury (Survey Monkey).</p> <p>Support the Community Speed Watch Scheme.</p> <p>Note that consideration of the closure of the western arm of the oak tree junction (Milton Road/Horn Hill Road) will be deferred until the results of the proposed 20 mph speed restrictions survey are known.</p>
Reasons for the Recommendation	To improve road safety in the village.
Impact on Budget	<p>The cost to access Survey Monkey is £106 for a year.</p> <p>The traffic survey conducted by the County Council costs £1170 plus VAT and the monitoring will take place at 13 locations in the village.</p>
Risks	If the speeding and volume of traffic in the village is not addressed, the issues will continue and have an impact on residents.
Background	<p>Thames Valley Police have relaunched the Community Speedwatch Scheme. Local resident Bob Meadows is kindly leading on the project on behalf of the Parish Council. In total, there are three volunteers assisting with the Scheme, however one further volunteer is required for it to be able to re-start.</p> <p>The application for 20mph speed restrictions in Adderbury has been submitted to Oxfordshire County Council. This application was supported by County Councillor Arash Fatemian.</p> <p>To support the application, traffic surveys will be carried out by the County Council in 13 locations to analysis the speed and volume of traffic in Adderbury.</p> <p>A survey has also been published on-line for residents to complete. A request has been made to Contact for the survey to be included in the centre pages of the May edition, to enable residents who cannot access the survey electronically, the opportunity to comment.</p> <p>The survey also includes questions with regard to whether or not the</p>
