

Milton Road site

The community building planning application has been lodged with Cherwell District Council (CDC) and can be seen on their planning website, reference no: **19/02796/F**. Once planning permission has been given, we will begin by applying for large grants to cover the cost of the building work. This stage can only go forward when enough funds have been committed to the project by grant awarding bodies. Publicity boards, showing the site layout and internal plans of the building, can be viewed at Adderbury library, the WFAC website and on display at our fundraising events.

Preparation of the sports pitches at the Milton Road site will begin in the Spring or when the weather permits.
