Preparation work for the sports pitches continues at the Milton Road site and now that planning permission for the proposed community building has been granted, we are finalising the Business Plan and continuing research into possible grants in order to raise the shortfall of funds required.

We are hoping to go ahead with the **Adderbury Community Day** on **Saturday, 19th September** although we will need to check Government guidelines on this. (*Decision to be made at the end of July*).
