Title of Report	Dog Waste Bins
Summary	To discuss new dog waste bins for Adderbury lakes and Kemps Road/The Crescent
Recommendation	A new dog waste bin be purchased for Adderbury Lakes. Further consultation be carried out with residents before a new dog waste bin is purchased for Kemps Road/The Crescent.
Reasons for the Recommendation	Siting a new dog waste bin in the community is always a contentious issue and before the Parish Council spends money on a bin which the community may not want, it would be useful to consult with the residents. There should not be any issues with installing a bin at Adderbury Lakes.
Impact on Budget	£389.99, plus VAT plus installation.
Risks	Even with the purchase of new dog waste bins, people still might not use them.
Background	A resident who walks along The Crescent and Kemps Road contacted the Parish Council asking for a new dog waste bin because dog waste was a particular issue. The Dog Warden has already been advised of the issue in this area and had previously erected signs. However residents made complaints to CDC and he had to remove them again. I have asked the resident who made the request for a new bin, to assist with consulting those who live close to where she thinks would be a suitable site.
