<b>Background</b>	<p>Representations from Deddington, Bodicote, Cropredy and Adderbury PCs, and 2 local residents.</p> <p>Rural taskforce set up for Cherwell - 8 PCs and 1 sgt. Priorities discussed for the next few months</p> <p>Open spaces and ASBOs predominantly patrolling local parks mostly Thu/Fri/Sat/Sun on later shifts to disperse gatherings and deter crime.</p> <p>County line drugs- no changes in recent months, still an issue.</p> <p>Bodicote report an increase in discarded gas casings, described as legal highs. Advised to report if an issue locally and officers will do their best to patrol.</p> <p>Adderbury reported recent increase in eggings of houses, now seems to be passing cars, advised to report via 101 or if dangerous 999.</p> <p>"Nottingham knockers"- have to have a licence signed by Chief constable to operate in this area, if they become an issue advised to call and report as the police can move them on.</p> <p>Farmers local watt sap group has been successful in reporting quickly and thefts or issues of fly tipping etc.</p> <p>Next meeting 4th October at 6.30pm.
