| Impact on Budget | None - £353.00 is ring fenced in the Parish Council funds for the defibrillator following fundraising which was undertaken in the village, when the unit was purchased. From Welmedical, the pads are £36.00, battery is £176.00, plus delivery. |
| Risks | If the unit is not maintained properly, it may not work properly in the case of an emergency. |
| Background | The village defibrillator was purchased in 2018 and is located out of The Bell in High Street, Adderbury. It was purchased following fundraising by Chris Shallis, landlord of The Bell. |
