Title of Report	Parking in The Rise
Summary	To discuss the continuing issues with vehicles being parked on the grass in The Rise.
Recommendation	<p>The Parish Council to consider:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. writing to residents again requesting that they do not park on the green in The Rise; 2. erecting 'No Parking' signs on the green; and 3. if parking does then still continue, the Parish Council will investigate other options such as bollards and/or enforcement to stop the parking.
Reasons for the Recommendation	<p>A number of residents park on the green in The Rise and it is not designated or suitable for parking.</p> <p>Residents have already been written to, asking them not to park on the grass, but the problem persist.</p>
Impact on Budget	Minimal – cost of signs and letters to residents.
Risks	If the parking on the green continues, then the grass and kerbstones could get damaged and it could result in the whole green space being used as a car park, when it is an amenity area for people to enjoy and children to play. It also makes it more difficult for the grass cutting contractor to do his job properly if vehicles are parking in the way.
